

WARREN COUNTY ELECTORAL BOARD MINUTES

NOVEMBER 9, 2022

CANVAS OF THE GENERAL AND SPECIAL ELECTIONS

November 8, 2022

The meeting was called to order 9:30 a.m. Board members present were Marilyn King, Chairman; Bob Hill, Vice Chairman; and Lee Bowen, Secretary. Carol Tobin, Director of Elections was also present. No observers or any one from the public was in attendance.

The meeting went into close session for the provisional ballot meeting. This was recessed at 10:45 a.m., as Carol Tobin, Director of Elections needed to research the voters records to determine if their provisional ballots qualify to be counted.

The Electoral Board moved on with the Canvas of the Election of each precinct:

101 Fork Town Precinct had an OVI ballot that wasn't machine counted; therefore, the Officers were called in to hand-count and include the results on the SOR.

202 Linden Precinct only provided one set opening and closing EPB statements.

0301 North River Precinct only provided one set of opening and closing EPB statements.

0302 Riverton Precinct reported that the absentee count changed during the day on the Pollbook; however, Carol Tobin, Director of Elections clarified that was due to voters bringing in their mailed unvoted absentee ballot to the precinct and voting in person.

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0401 East Shenandoah Precinct reported absentee opening and closing different, this was clarified by the voters bringing their mailed unvoted absentee ballot to the precinct and voting in person; Plus, no ballot reconciliation

This meeting was recessed until Monday, November 14, 2022, at 1:15 p.m. The meeting reconvened and present for this meeting was Marilyn King, Chairman; Bob Hill, Vice Chair; and Lee Bowen, Secretary. Carol Tobin was also present.

On Monday, November 14, 2022 the CAP (Central Absentee Precinct) met to count any Post Election Ballots received that were post-marked on or before Election Day and received by noon on the third day after the Election. Only one ballot received qualified to be counted.

The Electoral Board reconvened the Provisional Ballot Meeting at 2:00 p.m. to count qualifying Provisional ballots. Two Authorized Representatives were present. A total of 103 Provisional ballot were counted:

0101 = 6
0102 = 5
0201 = 11
0202 = 20
0301 = 3
0302 = 4
0401 = 12
0402 = 8
0501 = 9
0502 = 6
0504 = 5
CAP = 14

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Voting was closed at 2:19 p.m.

The closed session of the Electoral Board went back into open session and the meeting was adjourned at 3:05 p.m.

The Electoral Board Met again on November 15, 2022 at 1:30 p.m. to complete the canvas process and sign the abstracts. Members present was Marilyn King, Chairman; Bob Hill, Vice Chairman; and Lee Bowen, Secretary. Carol Tobin, Director of Elections was also present. The Electoral Board signed and attested the Abstracts, and the meeting was adjourned at 2:30 p.m.
